37 members present; 16 cars

President Steve Bloyed opened the meeting. He gave the Treasurer's report. Currently there is \$3,398.81 in the account. Arlan indicated he had a couple of bills that still need to be paid, and Janis also has one bill that she needs reimbursement for. Steve asked for a motion to approve the minutes from the July meeting. Eric Nelson moved that the minutes be approved; the motion was seconded and the motion carried.

On September 17, the club will be cruising to the Rimrock Café for breakfast. There will be more information on this at a later date.

Mary Ann Miesner brought up a discussion regarding the car show and crazy days. She is recommending that the dates for the car show be moved to July 14, 15 & 16 for 2012 so the La Grande car show is not held on the same weekend as Fossil and Hermiston. She is also recommending that the Car Club take over running Crazy Days, which is held the same weekend as the car show. Eric Laurence, who is on the Main Street Board, has offered his services to help with this event, and she indicated that Deb White also has volunteered to help. After discussion, Mary Ann made a motion to move the 2012 car show to July 14, 15 & 16 and have the Car Club take over running Crazy Days. John Bozarth seconded the motion, and the motion carried.

John Bozarth feels we should have put a thank-you ad in the newspaper for sponsors and donors. The general feeling of members was that it isn't too late to do this. John Bozarth moved and Mary Ann Miesner seconded the motion that a thank-you ad be put in the newspaper. The motion carried.

Mary Ann brought up a discussion regarding having Frank Carlson perform at the 2012 car show. After discussion, Steve Bloyed moved that we contact Frank Carlson to see if he would be available for next year's car show. The motion was seconded by Mary Ann. Motion carried.

Chris Gray asked where the money goes that was made on the car show. Steve said that \$500 - \$600 is used as a start-up fund for next year's show. Arlan Miesner moved that \$500 be donated to the Senior Center. The motion was seconded by Lloyd Hoke. Motion carried.

Steve Bloyed said that 9 cars from the car club were at the North Powder car show. La Grande received the "Club Participation" award. It was also mentioned that La Grande received a red ribbon for being in the Union County Fair Parade.

Steve reminded club members that the Union Grass Roots Festival/Car Show is Saturday, August 13, and encouraged club members to try and support Union's car show.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
