

## **Union County Timber Cruisers Car Club**

### **November 8, 2011 Minutes**

17 members present

President Steve Bloyed opened the meeting at approximately 6:05 p.m. Steve asked for a motion to approve the minutes. Arlan Miesner moved and John Bozarth seconded that the minutes be approved. Motion carried.

Wayne Weller gave the treasurer's report. After the bills are paid, there will be \$3,194.48 in the account. The treasurer's report was approved.

There was discussion on the "Trunk or Treat" held downtown on Halloween. Steve said that there were 5 or 6 cars there, and most of the candy was handed out. John Lackey thought maybe we might need more candy next year; \$100 was spent on candy, and Bertha Feik also brought candy to give out.

Wayne thanked everyone for their prayers for Sheralyn. Arlan moved that Wayne purchase flowers for Sheral from the club since he knows what she likes, seconded by Steve Whitmore.

Arlan said that La Grande Main Street has asked the club to have a float in the Christmas parade, which will be the Friday after Thanksgiving. The theme is "Winter Wonderland." The parade will start at 6:00 p.m.

Kathy Rudd, a Mary Kay representative, has asked if the club, or its individual members, would like to adopt a grandparent for Christmas. The cost is \$25 and this goes to purchase a stocking that will be filled with gifts to be given to an elderly person in a nursing home. John Bozarth moved and Tana McClay seconded the motion to purchase four grandparent stockings. Motion approved.

At the last meeting, Mary Ann was asked to see what the cost would be to put a half-page ad in the Chamber magazine to advertise the Timber Cruisers car show and Crazy Days. Twenty five thousand (25,000) copies of the magazine are printed each year and they are distributed throughout the whole state, at rest areas, motels, etc. The cost for us would be \$450 for a half-page ad if Main Street contributes half. After some discussion on this, Dave McClay moved that we purchase a full-page ad even if Main Street does not contribute to the cost. Mary Ann will contact Main Street to see if they will pay half the cost. Motion was seconded by Steve Bloyed. Motion approved.

Arlan reported that the Main Street monthly newsletter, which promotes events, will include info on the car club's car show at no cost to the club.

Arlan said that we have also been asked to have a float in the Elgin and Union parades in December. We will need to decide which one we will participate in and what we want as far as a float is concerned.

Steve presented the Second Place ribbon that the car club received for participating in the Union County Fair Parade.

President Steve announced that on January 14 the club will have a potluck in Island City. We need new officers for next year. John Lackey will chair the nominating committee. Submit names to John Lackey or bring names to the December meeting. Positions to be filled are: President, Vice President, Treasurer, Secretary, Activities Planner.

Eric Nelson moved and it was seconded that the meeting be adjourned. The meeting was closed at 6:30 p.m.
